Layers of Social Change: Gender and Geographic Information

As the medium of the map has changed, the data and society reflected in the map have evolved. Geographic information is now almost ubiquitous in mobile phones and online repositories, but that information is not created. Some demographics have contributed more and the corpus of crowdsourced information (Wikipedia, Google, OpenStreetMap) is reflective of those perspectives. Many of the maps used in everyday life simultaneously maintain and reproduce race, class, and gender biases. This talk will discuss these social, spatial, and gender biases in geospatial data and how social change can happen online through democratic processes. It will also reflect on the role of municipal open data in social processes.

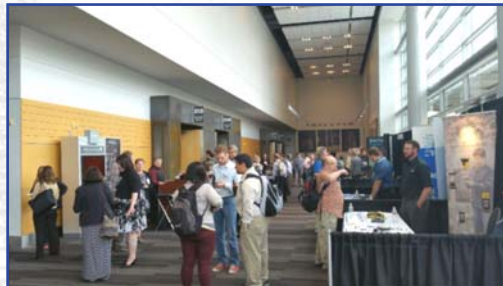

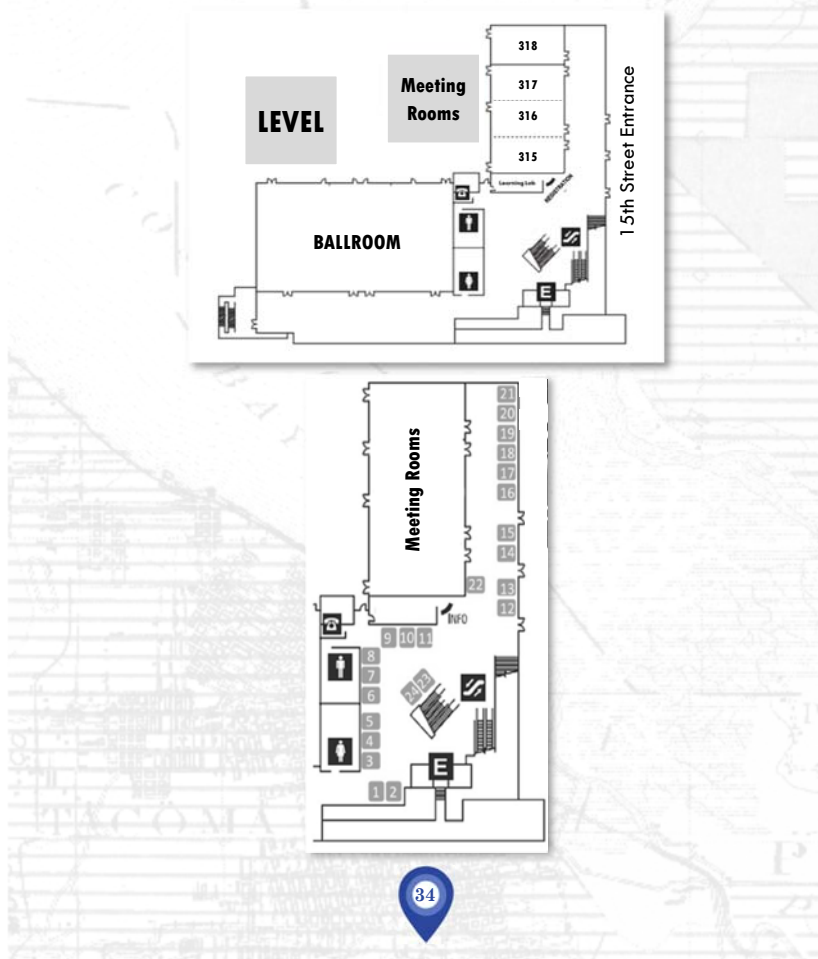
